Student Services fee and the technology fee are non-refundable and applied to every student, whether full or part-time.

Nonresident fee is non-refundable.

Dormitory room fees are non-refundable.

Lab Fees are non-refundable

Half of total fees are due at time of registration.

Refund Policy

A student who withdraws from school during the first full week of classes will receive a refund of 100 percent of the general fee, the second week, 75 percent; the third week, 50 percent; and the fourth week, 25 percent. After the fourth week, no refund will be made.

DAY CLASSES

First Week: August 14 through August 18, 2017

Second Week: August 21 through August 25, 2017

Third Week: August 28 through September 1, 2017

Fourth Week: September 4 through September 8, 2017

One completed day into each week means that the period for that week is used in calculating the refund.

No refund will be made for room rent after the first week.

Meal adjustments follow same as tuition.

No refund for evening classes after the first week.

No refund will be made for lab fees.

No refund will be made for the Student Services or Technology Fees.

No refund will be made for out-of-state fees.

No student will be allowed to officially withdraw until all fees are paid.

When there are mitigating circumstances, an appeal of the refund policy may be made in writing to the Counselors Office.

Course Material Fees

A course material fee is added to every student's account in the Business Office. The full time fee is \$250 and the part time fee is \$125. The course material fee is refundable **ONLY** during the first week of school.

In addition to the fee, students have the option to purchase a paper copy of the needed book(s) in the bookstore.

The bookstore accepts cash, check, visa, or mastercard.

Students with approved grants or scholarships may use their financial aid for this fee.

Where is the bookstore? The bookstore is currently located inside the Horace Holmes Student Union building, which is located next to the Horace Holmes Gymnasium and across the street from the Career Technical Building on Student Union Drive.
